



FNP ON-CAMPUS INTENSIVES FOR ONLINE STUDENTS

All students entering the online MSN FNP program will be required to attend two on-campus intensive sessions. These sessions are designed to help perfect assessment and practice skills for the advanced practice nurse. The on-campus sessions occur at the Sacramento campus. Specific dates will be shared upon approval from the University.

Goal of Session 1, N671L	To prepare students in the N671L Advanced Physical Assessment course for entering the first clinical rotation, N678L
Desired outcome	Increased preparedness for their first advanced practice clinical setting.
Goal of Session 2, N679L	To evaluate clinical competency of students entering into their final clinical rotation, N680L.
Desired outcome	Preparedness for advanced practice clinical competencies and management of more complex patients.

Attendance Session 1, N671L	2 consecutive days Semester 1, Week 13 (exception for holidays; then will be in Week 14)
Day 1: 12pm to 6pm	Orientation to clinical expectations including introduction to participating faculty, review of head-to-toe assessment; review SOAP notes. System practice stations. Dinner social event follows.
Day 2: 8am to 6pm	Breakfast & Lunch provided. Dinner on your own. Students will move through multiple stations while being observed by faculty; focused on becoming proficient in advanced practice skills. Debrief of the day.

Attendance Session 2, N679L	3 consecutive days Semester 5, Week 12 (Semester 6, Week 12 for PT students)
Day 1: 12pm to 6pm	Case presentation practice. Objective simulated clinical exams (OSCEs) stations, including Standardized Patient (SP) encounters. Debriefing follows. Lunch & dinner on own.
Day 2: 8am to 6pm	Breakfast & Lunch provided. Dinner on your own. OSCE stations with extensive debriefing.
Day 3: 8am to 6pm	Breakfast & Lunch provided. Dinner on your own. OSCE stations with extensive debriefing.
